MINNEAPOLIS TO BOSTON

DAY 4 FRIDAY, OCTOBER 2 (B,L,D)

PORTLAND-LINCOLN

We'll meet our local guide for a tour of Portland, Maine's largest city by the sea. Visit the most photographed lighthouse in the world, **Portland Head Lighthouse**. Travel past Longfellow's boyhood home, sea captain's homes, the elegant Victoria Mansion and the islands of Casco Bay in Portland Harbor. Next we travel inland to **Mount Washington Cog Railway**, the first mountain-climbing cog railway in the world. We will enjoy a box lunch while traveling to the Summit of Mount Washington. Then we travel the **Kancamagus Scenic Byway** through the White Mountains of New Hampshire before we settle in for an included dinner.

DAY 5 SATURDAY, OCTOBER 3 (B,L)

BARRE-MONTPELIER-KILLINGTON/RUTLAND

Relax and enjoy the scenic drive through the picturesque hillsides of Vermont as we make our way to Killington/Rutland for our evening stay.

BERKSHIRE MOUNTAINS
