#### WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 1 (D)

Board your flight from Minneapolis to San Diego. Transfer to the warm and sunny Temecula Valley area, just 60 miles north of San Diego. Rural in nature, sustainable in farming practices and including an agricultural preserve known as the Citrus/Vineyard zone, the Temecula Valley is widely recognized as the 'jewel' of Riverside County. Our first private wine tour and tasting is at Leoness Cellars followed by dinner at Café Champagne, located at Thornton Winery.

#### THURSDAY, OCTOBER 2 (B,L,D)

We begin our day with winery visits at Hart Winery, which crafts wines from a "place where the sun shines through the mist" and Maurice Car'rie Vineyard and Winery. We depart late morning to begin our Chardonnay Wine Tour, which includes a three-course luncheon at The Pinnacle Restaurant at Falkner Winery, Diner's Choice winner in 2012 and best chef two years in a row. Following lunch we will visit Callaway Vineyard and Winery for a behind-the-scenes tour and tasting. Our final tasting is at Baily Vineyard and Winery, one of Temecula's oldest wineries. A group dinner tonight in Temecula Old Town is included.

#### FRIDAY, OCTOBER 3 (B.L)

Today we tour the Temecula Olive Oil Ranch paired with a BBQ lunch. "Since the beginning, Temecula Olive Oil Company has been family-owned and operated, committed to using only California olives to make the highest quality olive oil. On our olive ranch, we practice sustainable agriculture, growing and harvesting a wide variety of olives, which we hand press using traditional methods to produce fresh, full-flavored extra virgin olive oil." Enjoy a 90-minute behind-the-scenes guided walking tour and olive oil tastings. The BBQ lunch is prepared with the day's fresh press. In the evening, we will have free time at Pechanga Casino. The Pechanga People have called Temecula Valley their home for more than 10,000 years. In their native language, Luiseño, Pechanga literally means, "place where the water drips". Here you will find California's largest gaming casino which offers fine and casual dining options for your dinner tonight (on your own). Hotel shuttle will be available for your convenience.

## SATURDAY, OCTOBER 4 (B,D)

Today we explore Temecula Old Town. Established in 1882 when the California Railroad put the valley on the map, this historic district offers unique local history combined with modern conveniences. Along with historical flair, the picturesque downtown backdrop is home to trendy boutiques, elegant restaurants, local wine tasting venues, a plethora of antique shops, and family-friendly attractions. Stop by the Temecula Museum or stroll through the farmer's market. The afternoon and evening hours are spent enjoying a unique progressive dinner wine tour at 3 wineries. Appetizers will be served at Falkner Winery, main course at Wilson Creek Winery and Vineyard, and dessert at South Coast Winery. In addition, each course is paired with an exquisite taste of a Temecula vintage wine.

### SUNDAY, OCTOBER 5 (B)

Our transfer back to the San Diego airport is following breakfast. We hope you've made many memories and discovered a favorite wine or two!
