

Congratulations to Dharani Ramamoorthy, founder of Xylo Technologies on 20 years in business in Rochester. Dharani has been named a 2020 R.AV.E. (Recognizing Awarding Valuing Entrepreneurs) Honoree.

How did you come up with the idea of starting Xylo Technologies?

I started my career as an IT Consultant working with different clients like IBM and Mayo Clinic in Rochester for more than eight years. During these years, I noticed that there was a huge disconnect in servicing the needs of clients and what was being provided in the market. I was keen on creating an organization that could address these gaps most effectively. Leveraging on this disconnect and capitalizing on this opportunity was the spark that led to the formation of Xylo Technologies in 2000.

What was the most challenging part of starting your business?

IT staffing industry is very competitive, and all our clients have multiple vendors to service them. However, we differentiated ourselves from the competition and grew the business. Now we work with many large clients across the nation. Finding talent is another big challenge we faced. But with our best business practices we were able to attract talent.
