

#### **Total Employment**

Nonagricultural wage and salary employment for the Rochester MSA increased by 1.9 percent over the last year. The gain of 2,194 jobs brought the total employment figure to 115,528 from the March 2015 level of 113,334. Both Goods Producing and Service Providing reported gains in the last year.

### Unemployment

The Rochester MSA unemployment rate dropped by .2 percent from a year ago, ending first quarter at 3.9 percent. The rates for January and February were both 3.9 percent. The Rochester average remains below the state and U.S. averages of 4.6 and 5.1 percent respectively.


The March labor force figure of 120,703 represents an increase of 2.3% percent from the March 2015 figure of 117,940.

#### **Quarterly Airport Traffic**

The Rochester International Airport serviced 53,234 passengers during the first quarter of 2016. This represents a decrease of 3.4 percent over first quarter 2015 (55,110 passengers) and 4.4 percent over first quarter 2014 (55,670 passengers). Passenger totals for January, February and March were 18,414, 15,983 and 18,837 respectively.

Air cargo shipments were up .9 percent from first quarter 2015.





#### Net Sales Tax - Past 5 Years



#### **First Quarter Building Activity**

Commercial and residential building permits issued for first quarter 2016 totaled \$120,241,049. This represents increases of 35.3 percent over first quarter 2015, 52.6 percent over 2014, 244.6 percent over 2013, and 28.9 percent over 2012.

Permits over \$1 million for first quarter 2016 included: St. Mary's east corridor, radiology alterations at St. Mary's, 96 unit 3-story Pine Apartments, new 12,914 square foot mezzanine and walls for garden center (Menards-North), mechanical, plumbing and electrical modifications for data center (Mayo-Epic-Enterprise Data Center), new 58x113 2-story daycare (New Horizon Academy), new 3-story Garden North Apartments (buildings A&B), alterations to hotel rooms for floors 2-7 (Hilton Garden Inn), and alterations for genome remodel at Mayo Clinic.

#### **First Quarter Home Sales**

First quarter sales of single family homes in Rochester were \$76,057,613. This represents a decrease of 19.3 percent over first quarter 2015, and an increase of 19.9 percent over 2014, 15.7 percent over 2013, and 37 percent over 2012.

The average home in Rochester sold for \$208,377 during the first quarter of 2016, and the median sale price was \$169,900. There were 365 units sold during the first quarter and the average time on the market was 100 days.
