Please bring a packed lunch and a morning snack. An afternoon snack is provided for children staying after 3:30 pm. Please apply sunscreen in the morning, and send a bottle of sunscreen, a hat and a water bottle to school each day. With <u>parental permission</u> (form will be sent home) the teacher can also apply sunscreen to the camper's skin. You will be billed through the TADS system. Half of the charges will be invoiced upon receipt of camp registration. The remaining charges will be invoiced for payment on June 1.
