


## 5.A. Legislative Priorities



### Legislative Update | 2026 Legislative Priority Development

#### **State Issues**

- State Bonding Request
  - East Zumbro Sewer and Water Infrastructure for Housing
- Special Sales Tax Exemption Request
  - Propose special legislation for sales tax exemptions on not-forprofit utility projects: Advanced Metering
- Transmission Investment Right of First Refusal (ROFR)
  - Protect ROFR rights related to transmission investments *AND* require load ratio share of future investment to be offered load serving entities.
- Definition of Large Energy Facility
  - The current definition of Large Energy Facility is 50MW or greater. Support legislation to define Large as 100MW legislation related to cost based and fair net metering reforms.
- Net Metering Reform
  - Support legislation related to cost based and fair net metering reforms.






### Legislative Update | 2026 Legislative Priority Development

#### Nuclear Power Generation

- Support legislation introduced to remove the moratorium or further study advanced reactor designs
- Explore model legislation from other states to allow access to nuclear generation to non-for-profit utilities on a pro-rata share
- Proposed Reforms to MN Energy Conservation and Optimization (ECO) Act
  - Modernize metrics to recognize verified demand response and load-shifting measures.
  - Streamline statewide reporting to reduce administrative efforts and improve transparency, benchmarking, and alignment with state conservation and emissions targets.

### Federal Issues

- Sustain Federal Funding for the ENERGY STAR Program
  - Provide sustained appropriations (~ \$40M annually) to maintain ENERGY STAR's current scope
