Have you ever been curious about what's inside a wellhouse or how water travels from an aquifer to your home? In celebration of Drinking Water Week May 4-10, 2025, RPU invites customers to a special open house for a behindthe-scenes look at the city's water system.



Drinking Water Week highlights the importance of safe, reliable drinking water and recognizes the dedicated professionals who ensure it flows 24/7. RPU's open house is the perfect opportunity to learn more about this essential resource and the people who help provide it.

Join RPU's water staff for a look inside the Apache Mall water tower and wellhouse on Friday, May 9 from 2-6pm. The Apache Mall water tower, a spheroid water storage facility, holds up to 500,000 gallons of water. In comparison, the St. Mary's Reservoir can store six times as much, around 3,300,000 gallons! Come and discover the process that ensures more than 42,000 customers in Rochester receive clean, safe drinking water every day. Whether this is your first visit, or you attended last year, this event is a great way to see firsthand how Rochester's water system operates.

Backflow Assembly Testing is Required Annually

Providing safe drinking water is a top priority for Rochester Public Utilities (RPU). To protect the public water supply from contamination, RPU follows strict standards set by the Federal Safe Drinking Water Act, Minnesota Department of Health, Minnesota Plumbing Code, and our own Water Service Rules & Regulations. One key safeguard is preventing backflow, which is the reverse flow of potentially contaminated water into the clean water system. This can happen when there is a sudden change in water pressure. Since we all share the same water supply, backflow prevention is a shared responsibility.



Minnesota Plumbing Code requires all backflow prevention assemblies, both at the water meter and throughout your property, to be tested annually by a certified tester. Types of backflow prevention assemblies include Reduced Pressure Zone (RP) assemblies, Double Check Valve (DC) assemblies,

Pressure Vacuum Breakers (PVB), and Spill Resistant Vacuum Breakers (SVB). It is the responsibility of the homeowner or business owner to schedule this test each year. Regular testing ensures these devices are working properly to keep our water safe. For more information, visit **rpu.org/education-environment/backflow-prevention-program.php**.

2024 Water Quality Report

Municipal water utilities, including RPU, are highly tested and scrutinized for safety and quality. In accordance with the Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA's) Safe Drinking Water Act, the testing results over the past year are compiled and made available for the public. Each May, RPU releases the consumer confidence report (CCR) publicly. This year, RPU is pleased to announce that water provided by RPU, again met all State and Federal drinking water standards. Power Up Your Summer with Energy-Smart Choices

With longer days and better weather ahead, it's a great time to switch to electric-powered options for both transportation and yard care. Whether you're considering an electric vehicle (EV), an e-Bike, or battery-powered lawn equipment, RPU offers rebates to help you make the transition.

NEW! Battery-Powered Equipment Rebates

Make the switch to battery-powered lawn equipment and receive rebates for eligible purchases. These quieter, cleaner alternatives to gas-powered equipment help reduce emissions and noise pollution.

Eligible equipment and rebate amounts:

- \$100 per battery-powered riding lawn mower.
- \$50 per battery-powered push lawn mower.
- \$10 per battery-powered chainsaw, lawn trimmer, or leaf blower.

Eligiblity:

- All equipment must be new and battery-powered to qualify.
- Mowers must have a battery voltage of at least 36 volts to qualify.
- Corded equipment and robotic mowers do not qualify for a rebate.
- Rebates are limited to 50% of the equipment cost.
- Rebate quantities are limited to two riding mowers and five push lawn mowers, blowers, trimmers, and chainsaws annually.
- Purchase date on invoice/receipt must be between January 1, 2025 and December 31, 2025.

NEW! E-Bike Rebate

RPU now offers a rebate for electric-assisted bicycles (e-Bikes), making it more affordable to choose a clean, energy-efficient mode of transportation.

Eligiblity:

- \$150 per e-Bike (not to exceed 50% of cost).
- Eligible e-Bikes must be new, include a battery, electric motor, seat, and functional pedals.
- Used, rebuilt, resold, or warranty/insurance claim e-Bikes do not qualify.
- · Electric bicycle conversion kits are not eligible.
- Purchase must be made between January 1, 2025 and December 31, 2025.



Electric Vehicle (EV) Rebates

RPU supports customers who choose electric vehicles with rebates based on enrollment in a Time-of-Use (TOU) Rate. TOU rates encourage EV charging during off-peak hours (10pm-8am) to help lower overall energy costs.

TOU Rate Enrollment Incentives:

- Enrolling Now: EV owners who enroll in a TOU Rate now can receive a \$500 rebate for their first EV and a \$150 rebate for each additional qualifying EV.
- Currently Enrolled: EV owners already on a TOU Rate who purchase an additional qualifying EV can receive a \$150 rebate per EV.

Eligible Vehicles:

- All-Electric EV Powered solely by an electric battery.
- Plug-In Hybrid EV Similar to a hybrid but with a larger battery and electric motor.
- Not Eligible: Hybrid EVs that cannot be plugged in are NOT eligible for this rebate.

EV owners must also acknowledge the TOU rate structure, understanding that shifting electricity use to off-peak hours can reduce costs, while excessive on-peak use may result in higher bills.



NEW! EV Charger Rebate

For customers installing a new ENERGY STAR[®] qualified, AC-output Level 2 EV charger with connected capabilities, RPU offers a \$15 rebate per charger.

To qualify:

- The charger must be fully installed and operational before applying.
- Must be purchased new between January 1, 2025 and December 31, 2025.
- EV manufacturer-provided chargers do not qualify.



How to Apply

To take advantage of these rebates, complete an application and submit it along with the required documentation, including proof of purchase and product specifications. Applications are processed on a first-come, first-served basis, and funds are limited.

During periods of high electricity demand, from May 1-September 30, you'll agree to allow RPU to make minor temperature adjustments (2-4 degrees) to your smart thermostat^ during Peak Savings Events. (Peak Savings Events will not occur on weekends or holidays.)

NEW Large Commercial Benchmarking Law

In 2023, the Minnesota Legislature passed Minnesota Statute 216C.331, the Energy Benchmarking law, which requires commercial customers within RPU's service territory who meet the square footage requirements to electronically upload their energy usage into the United States Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA) Energy Star Portfolio Manager (ESPM). Buildings over 100,000 square feet must submit their energy usage data by June 1, 2025. Starting next year, this program will also apply to buildings 50,000 square feet and larger.
