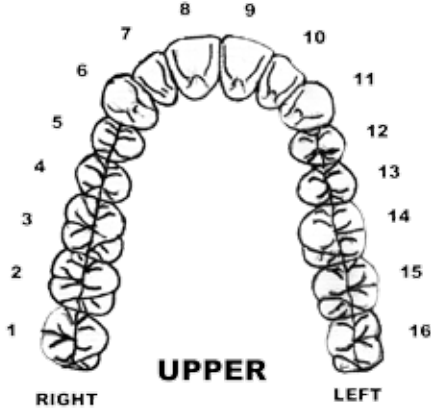

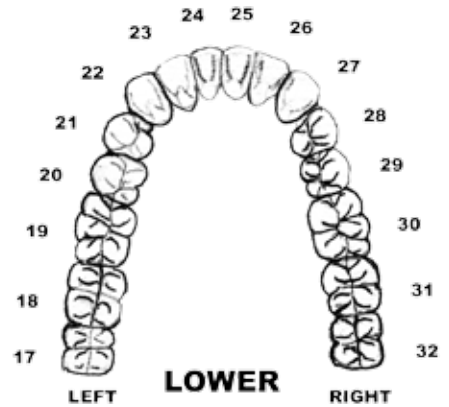

Other Considerations: _____

1) Prepare: (G.P.) Guiding Planes where marked in Black



2) Prepare: (R) Rest where marked in Red.

(A) Mesial or Distal rest should be prepared about 1/2 the depth of a no8 burr

(B) Embrassure rest. About 1mm wide, and 1mm in depth to allow room for clasp

(C) Cingulum rest. At least .5mm or as much as you can reduce. Also keep below occ.

(D) Cingulum rest for rotational path. Rest straight across cingulum
