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Zumbro Valley Health Center Receives Major Grant from Bremer Trust

Rochester, Minn. – Otto Bremer Trust has awarded Zumbro Valley Health Center \$100,000 to help the organization develop a metabolic clinic within its primary care area. Funding will allow primary care staff to better treat diseases common to people with mental illness such as metabolic syndrome, diabetes, cardiovascular disease and respiratory illnesses by addressing key lifestyle factors during visits.

"Research shows that people diagnosed with a mental illness live, on average, 25 years less than those without one," said Chief Executive Officer Beth Krehbiel, RN, FACHE. "This is primarily due to physical health conditions caused by obesity, lack of exercise, poor nutrition and other modifiable lifestyle factors."

Grant funds will be used to expand services through the addition of a consultant nutritionist to provide advice on proper diet, access to a trainer to instruct patients on proper exercise techniques and enhanced testing for the assessment of metabolic risk factors by primary care clinic staff.

"Zumbro Valley Health Center has worked for more than 50 years to improve the health of adults, adolescents, and children in southeast Minnesota, regardless of their ability to pay," said Brian Lipschultz, co-CEO and trustee, Otto Bremer Trust. "This grant will allow the organization's primary care clinic to provide expanded services that will lead to improved health outcomes for its patients."

Krehbiel added that Zumbro Valley Health Center staff have treated increased numbers of people with comorbid conditions over the past year, and that more than half of all patients are now diagnosed with a complex disorder.

"The severity of these medical issues is often critical as many of these individuals have not received basic care for years or even decades," she said. "This funding from Bremer Trust is crucial as we continue to add both new programs and staff to enhance the treatment options for this population."
