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Zumbro Valley Health Center Receives Major Grant from Bremer Trust

Rochester, Minn. – The Otto Bremer Trust recently awarded Zumbro Valley Health Center a \$91,569 grant to help support Zumbro Valley's integrated care model. This funding will be used to expand the delivery of mental health, medical and care coordination services to the under- and uninsured populations in Southeast Minnesota.

“This generous donation from the Otto Bremer Trust allows our organization to continue its move toward dedicated interdisciplinary health care teams to enhance the psychological, medical and social needs of our patients,” said Chief Executive Officer Dave Cook, LICSW, MSW. “Over the past two years, we have seen remarkable outcomes using this model of care, and this funding enables Zumbro Valley Health Center to expand to serve more people.”

Grant funds will be used to support staffing costs related to the care model.

“The benefits of an integrated health care approach like the one being used by Zumbro Valley Health Center enhances access to services, improves the quality of care and lowers overall health care costs,” said Lue Her, regional director for Otto Bremer Trust. “A key focus for these grants is how they move communities forward, and we are excited to support the work Zumbro Valley Health Center is performing with the region’s under-served populations.”

Cook said a number of existing patients have co-morbid conditions such as diabetes, obesity and heart disease along with their mental illness or addiction diagnoses. In order to help these individuals enhance their behavioral health, it's necessary to provide an integrated approach that incorporates other key factors in their lives.
