Rochester, Minn. – The Minnesota Dept. of Health recently re-certified Zumbro Valley Health Center an Essential Community Provider (ECP). This five-year certification recognizes health care organizations that serve high-risk, special needs and underserved people.

State regulations require that ECPs either provide or coordinate supportive and stabilizing services such as transportation, linguistic assistance and culturally sensitive services. The Department of Health completed a thorough review of Zumbro Valley to ensure it met key statutes and requirements, including:

- Serve all patients, regardless of their financial limitations
- Charge patients for their services based on a sliding-fee schedule, if the ECP is a non-profit organization
- Provide access for transport assistance, child care and language services
